Minor's Release, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement

We the undersigned, hereby request that the above named minor be granted permission (1) to enter the arena area, (2) to participate as a contestant, assistant, official or otherwise in rodeo events. (3) to compete for money, prizes, recognition or reward. (4) to be covered by family health insurance, if applicable. (5) to be covered medically, by parents or legal guardian (all collectively) hereinafter called "permissive entry")

In consideration of "permissive entry" to minor into the arena, which is the arena from which admission to the general public is restricted, which includes, but is not limited to the rodeo arena, competition area, chutes, pens, adjacent walkways, concessions and other apputenances, we the undersigned, on the behalf of the minor and fro ourselves, our personal representatives, heirs, next of kin, spouses and assigned, do hereby:

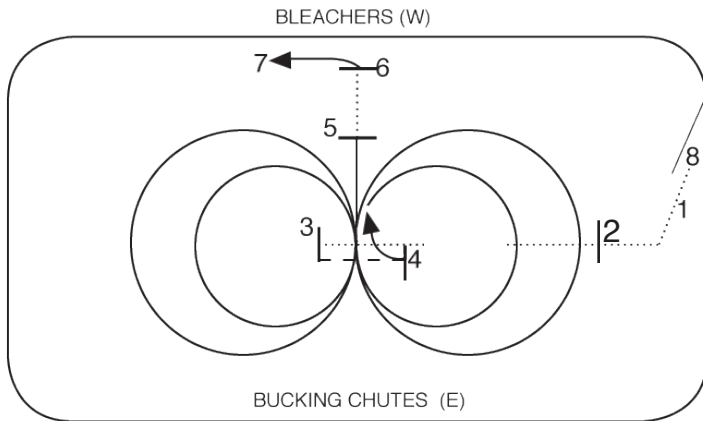
1. AGREE not to hold liable the rodeo committee, stock providers, arena operators or owners, and each of them, their officers, agents and employees (all herin after collectively referred to as "releases") from any and all claims and liability arising out of strict liability arising out of strict liability or ordinary negligence of releases or nay other participant which causes the undersigned injury, death, damages or property damages. We the undersigned, jointly, severally, and in common, covenant to hold releases harmless and indemnify releases from an, claim, judgment or expenses releases may incur arising out of any of the minor's activities or presence in the arena area.

2. RELEASOR or parents or guardians of the undersigned minor AGREE TO INDEMNIFY the Releases and each of them from say loss, liability, damage, or costs they might incur die to the presences or participation of the minor in the described activities wether caused by the negligence of the Releases or otherwise.

WE HAVE READ THIS DOCUMENT, WE UNDERSTAND IT IS A RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS. WE APPRECIATE AND ASSUME ALL RISK INHERENT IN THIS RODEO ACTIVITY.

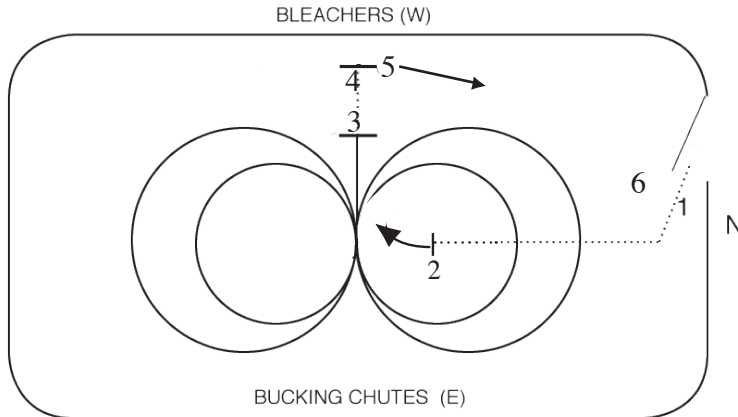

MISS BUCKAROO QUEEN PATTERN - AGES 10-13



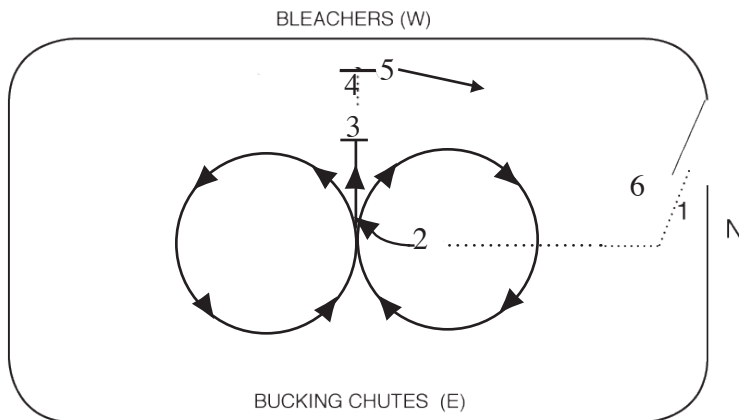
- 1 - Walk to point 2
- 2 - Lope to Point 3
- 3 - Stop and Back to Point 4
- 4 - 2 figure 8's: Small figure 8 slow, then larger figure 8 faster
- 5 - Stop and Settle for 10 seconds
- 6 - Walk to the judge, answer horsemanship questions
- 7 - Presentation ride around arena
- 8 - Exit Arena

JUNIOR MISS BUCKAROO QUEEN PATTERN - AGES 6-9



- 1 - Walk to point 2
- 2 - Begin small figure 8 at slow pace, then second figure 8 at faster pace
- 3 - Stop and Settle for 10 seconds
- 4 - Walk to the judge and answer horsemanship questions
- 5 - Queen wave to gate
- 6 - Exit Arena

JUNIOR MISS BUCKAROO QUEEN PATTERN - AGES 2-5



- 1 - Walk to point 2
- 2 - Begin small figure 8 at slow pace, then increase in speed for second loop
- 3 - Stop and Settle for 10 seconds
- 4 - Walk to the judge and answer horsemanship questions
- 5 - Queen wave to gate
- 6 - Exit Arena

Younger girls have the option of being lead in by a parent. Parent may lead through the pattern. No points will be docked for leading, but consideration will be given to contestant who can control their mount on their own.
